<u>Rules</u>

- 1. No more than 2 skips per rink
- 2. Curlers must have current RCCC membership and can only play for one club in Province competitions
- 3. Defaulting clubs forfeit points and must pay their own and opponents' ice charges.
- 4. Ice Rink '3 players may start' rule applies
- 5. The Free Guard Zone applies to the first five stones delivered each end
- 6. Scorecards must be completed, signed by skips and all players names included.

PERTH ICE RINK: SUMMARY OF COVID-19 RULES

Before play

- Arrive no more than 15 minutes before play
- If possible book and pay online
- Come as match-ready as possible; changing rooms are not in use but a shoe changing area will be available
- Wear a face mask when entering the building; this can be removed during play
- Bring your own hand sanitiser if possible
- No shaking of hands

During play

- Use the same numbered stones throughout the game
- Stick to 2-metre social distancing guidelines throughout
- One player per team nominated to complete the scorecard and whiteboard
- One sweeper only; sweeping from hog line at delivery end
- No sweeping of an opponent's stone after tee-line
- Minimise shouted instructions during play
- Return stones to the end where the game started at the end of the game
- Leave the ice sheet by the same entrance as you entered
- Return ice rink brushes and whiteboard markers in designated box at the exit to Ice Hall
- Leave the Ice Hall via the skate hire corridor and room.
