Information for Competing Teams

40 teams in 8 sections of 5.

No playing members of the Scottish Institute of Sport or British Curling Programme allowed to play in a team.

4 games in a round robin plus one bye.

Round robin games are 6 ends, 2 points for a win and 1 point for a draw.

Ranking is as follows, points, ends won, shots difference and shots scored.

Top team in each section will advance to the High Road quarter finals and second place teams go to the Low Road quarter finals.

Playoff games are 8 ends.

The decision of the committee will be final in all curling matters.

The players party with hot buffet, to which all teams are invited, takes place on Thursday evening directly following the completion of the quarter finals. If you or any members of your team have any dietary requirements please let us know by return email.
